## Re: Year 7 Residential Trip to Beam House, North Devon – July 2024

As part of our Year 7 Enrichment Programme, we are proposing to offer Year 7 students a chance to attend a residential trip at Beam House in North Devon. We have managed to secure 200 places at this popular centre so that there will be space for the vast majority of Year 7. The plan is for E band to depart on Monday 1 July and return on Wednesday 3 July and F band to depart on Wednesday 3 July and return on Friday 5 July. There will be more information to follow regarding groupings later on in the year.

The purpose of the trip is for students to develop confidence, self-esteem, communication and a whole host of other skills that foster positive relationships and improve both physical and mental well-being. We have an action packed three days in store for our students with a wide range of activities on offer. From surfing and kayaking in the Atlantic to abseiling and climbing on the beautiful Devon coastline, there will be something for everyone. When finished for the day, students will have the opportunity to take part in a wide range of evening activities including karaoke, 5 a-side football and a disco.

The cost of this trip has been heavily subsidised by the College with the total price of the trip being £110. This includes, travel, accommodation, all meals and all activities for the three days.

To confirm your child's place, a deposit of £30 is required by 1 December 2023. The balance will then be paid in instalments as shown in the table below. If you would prefer, you can pay the full amount of £110. This trip will be published on Parent Pay on Monday 16 October at 12 noon and will automatically close once all 200 spaces have been filled.
